Altadore Elementary School Council Annual Report 2024-2025

Review of School Year

We had a great start to the year with our Direct Donation Campaign and Casino this fall. The Altadore Elementary School Parents' Association exceeded its fundraising goal, raising \$48,412 from Direct Donation and \$82,956 from the Casino. Half of the casino funds have been designated for next year. These funds go to the school to enrich the student's educational experience with field trips, classroom support, Unity projects for families at Altadore School in need, multiple FunFit PhysEd residencies, Indigenous Elder Saa'kokoto residency, the Edible Garden, addition of new books for the school library, the purchase of new technology and more. A huge Thank you to our fundraising chair Amy Close for coordinating the Direct Donation Campaign.

A huge thank-you to our Casino Chair, Michelle Jung for coordinating the Casino. And thank you to all of the volunteers who worked the casino, particularly the late-night shifts! The Casino requires a lot of volunteers, but it raises and significant amount of money for the school. Our next casino is slated for Q4 2026.

In September, the Edible Garden charity bed donated Approximately 1035 lbs of produce to the Calgary Food Bank. A huge thank you to the Garden Committee: Emma Geoghagan, Katie Dodd, Kelsey Boudraa and Baiba Hesela and the Teachers and Students who nurtured the garden beds and participated in the harvest. We had our second annual Harvest Festival event where students and parents helped with harvest, participated in fun activities, and enjoyed some treats made from garden produce. We hope to expand this event next year.

The "Walk Safe" Committee looked into ways to address the safety concerns at the crosswalk in front of the school at 45 Ave. As a result, School Administration has put a focus on ensuring traffic cones are out at the crosswalk, and the City of Calgary has agreed to add new traffic calming measures around the crosswalk. We expect these to be installed before the beginning of the next school year. A Huge thank you to the Safe Walk Committee: Megan Gough, Adam Revay and Kristi McCallister.

The School Council continued to try to make it easier for parents to attend monthly meetings by investing in a webcam and microphone to improve virtual meetings. Thank you to Adam Revay for purchasing the technology and setting it up before all of our meetings this year. We organized a Spring Guest Speaker event at the end of April. Dr. Cheryl MacLeod from the Family Psychology Place presented on Impact of Screen Time and Social Media on Children's Development and Mental Health. It was an insightful presentation full of tips and considerations for parents and caregivers. Thanks to Dr Cheryl for donating her time for the event.

Alberta Education provided a \$500 grant to support the enhancement of parental involvement and engagement. With this, we started the Parent Lending Library. This is a resource for parents to borrow books on parenting, mental health, and technology use. The Parent lending library is located outside of the School Office. Please take some time to check it out!

The School Council funded Stream of Dreams this year. The students enjoyed painting their fish and now seeing them on display on the school fence. A huge thank you to Christiana Hawkins for coordinating the volunteers and the activities that week!

The School Council continued to organize staff appreciation lunches and snack days, Fun Lunch for the students this year, thank-you to Larissa Kennedy-Chan for her work coordinating Fun Lunch.
