<u>School Administration Update</u> (likiinayookaa & Karlee)

- G.6 presentation acknowledgment of the land & presentation (Miss Hutton & Miss Bigelow)
 - Outdoor School October 14-17
 - Bussed out to camp
 - Sept 24 Mandatory Parent Meeting
 - \$370 per student last year- \$70 funded by Council last year
 - Lots of curriculum tied education, science, social studies, indigenous studies
 - Community bonding, lots of opportunities for the kids to become independent and work as a team
 - Camp runs until November, then it closes, and re-opens in May
 - Question: If teachers are on strike what happens to camp? Answer: Unsure at this time, the camp is booked up most of the year, so unclear if we would be able to re-book
- Photo Day was today Sept 10
- Staffing and class configuration update
 - Learning Leading Team: Mrs.Predika and Mr.Mitchelson
 - Admin provided update on staff changes
 - Current Enrollment 353 (-22 from forecast)
 - For budget: changed one FTE from .6 to .5, EA's decreased from 25 to 20 hours, vacant lunchroom supervisor position not filled
 - Shared teacher class list
- Edible garden and Owl's Nest
 - Currently have an interim chair of the garden (Kelsey Boudraa)
 - Garden Chair can connect with teachers to see if we can have a volunteer harvesting with the kids in the fall. Reminder in the fall, Safeway is happy to give us boxes, we should do this again next year.
 - Question: What is the plan for other gardens? Grade 5/6 will go out this week, Friday is last day.
 - We need garden chair to get moving on harvest
